



FIXING A CLOUDY POOL

MAKING POOL CARE SIMPLE ALL YEAR ROUND

CAUTION:

Please remember that whenever you use pool chemicals you must read and follow the safety precautions on the label. Some of our products can be very harmful on the skin, in your eyes, or your mouth and lungs. You should keep all of them out of the reach of children, and never mix the chemicals together unless specifically instructed to do so.

There are two main reason why a pool will be cloudy.

- 1) It has not been chlorinated well
- 2) It has fine particles in the water too small for your filter to catch

To fix it

- 1) turn on your filter
- 2) balance the water (pH at least must be close to neutral at 7.2 - 7.8 for other chemicals to work well)
- 3) shock dose with Chlorine Granules, or Dichlor Granules
- 4) Allow the filter to run overnight and see if this corrects the problem. If it is still cloudy then the cloudiness is most likely caused by particles too small for your filter to pick up.
- 5) If it is only slightly cloudy then you can use Sparkle Cubes. These are very easy to use, just follow the instructions on the label.
- 5) If it is very cloudy use Splash Liqua Floc instead. Follow the instructions carefully, Liqua Floc will glue the small particles together and they will drop to the bottom of your pool in clumps for you to vacuum up.
